Your Internship Schedule includes:*

9AM—Help Open the Farm:

(Feeding horses, bringing in horses, and other horsey chores).

10 AM—Groom & Saddle Your Horse + Help Beginning Students with theirs.

11 AM—Senior Student for Lesson or Trail Ride.

(Yes, this is a riding activity for Junior Interns).

12:30 PM — Eat lunch with students, leasers and other staff. Extra Grooming.

1:30 PM — Young Horse Class or Helping New Students (on the ground).

3:30 PM—Patterns on Horseback or Games on Horseback

5 PM - Stable Management - Help Close the Farm*

(This includes unsaddling, turning out horses, feeding, watering, mucking stalls and other horsey chores).

5:30 - 5:45PM— All Done—See you next time!

Junior Interns come 2 days a month —either Wednesdays or Thursdays or Saturdays each month. This is a horse available program. Junior Interns are only accepted with instructor's permission.
